Camphill Special School recognized in 2010 Aster Awards Competition

Honored for excellence in the 2010 Aster Awards, Camphill Special School's tri-annual newsletter has received Gold recognition in this year's competition.

The Aster Awards, one of the largest national competitions of its kind, is hosted by ***Marketing Healthcare Today Magazine*** and Creative Images, Inc..

The 2010 Aster Awards received approximately 3,000 entries from across the United States as well as Canada and South America. Participant's entries competed against similar-sized organizations in their category. Entries must score at least in the top 85% to receive an award. Judging criteria includes creativity, layout and design, functionality, message effectiveness, production quality and overall appeal.

"It was an honor to have Camphill Special School participate in the 2010 Aster Awards Competition. They placed in the top 5% of the nation. The quality of this year's entries went well beyond the judges' expectations," said Melinda R. Lucas, Aster Awards Program Coordinator.

Camphill Special School, established in 1963, is a private residential and day school for children and youth with intellectual and developmental disabilities. The school is accredited by the Association of Waldorf Schools of North America and the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools Commissions on Elementary and Secondary Schools, as well as licensed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as an Approved Private School.
