**ProAm Tennis Tournament raises over \$107,000 for Camphill Special School**

Local tennis pro Kyle Hawthorne paired with Matt Bonds, a 4.5 rated amateur, to win the 2007 Camphill ProAm Tennis Tournament held May 12 at Valley Creek Park in Malvern.

The tournament, presented by PECO, An Exelon Company, and hosted by Tennis Addiction Sports Club and Camphill Special School, was preceded by the Camphill ProAm “Tennis Ball,” held at The Desmond Hotel on May 11. Bob Bowersox, on-air personality for QVC, served as emcee, while Jamie Apody, newscaster for ABC 6, acted as auctioneer.
