### **ProAm tennis tournament raises nearly \$100,000 for Camphill Special School**

The tournament, presented by PECO, an Exelon company, and hosted by Tennis Addiction Sports Club and Camphill Special School, was preceded by the Camphill ProAm “Tennis Ball,” held at The Desmond Hotel.
