Camphill ProAm Raises Record Amount for Special Needs Children

GLENMOORE, PA - The seventeenth annual Camphill Tennis Ball and ProAm Tennis Tournament on May 9 and 10, hosted by Tennis Addiction Sports Club and presented by PECO, An Exelon Company, raised over \$131,000 for Camphill Special School, a local day and residential school for children and youth with developmental disabilities.

On May 9 at the Desmond Hotel, the over 260 Tennis Ball patrons were treated to dinner, dancing, an appearance by Congressman Jim Gerlach, and auctions which raised over \$21,000. Spectators at the ProAm Tennis Tournament at Valley Creek Park on May 10 cheered on the eight tennis pairs battling for the championship trophies. After an intense final match, local pro Gino Carosella of Cheltenham Racquet Club and 4.5 rated amateur Andreas Schuschke, a housefather at Camphill Special School, took home the silver cups, beating certified USPTA pro Brian Zanzitis and 4.5 rated amateur Celes Panichelli.
